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Supervised Study 2024-2025 information leaflet

Holy Family Community School offers supervised study throughout the academic year to students in 2nd, 3rd, 5th and 6th year with students in exam years given priority for places. During supervised study students can complete assignments, homework and conduct independent study in a quiet environment with no distractions. Study takes place four days a week from 3.55pm to 5.55pm excluding Wednesdays.

Cost and dates of sessions for the 2024/2025 academic year.

There are seven sessions of study per academic year. Each session is 16 study periods. On nights where there is a parent teacher meeting or staff meeting scheduled study does not take place. These dates will be communicated prior to the commencement of each session. The start and finish date for the 2024/2025 sessions are outlined in the table below.

Sessions 1 to 6 will cost €65 each.

Session 7 is shorter in length and will cost €40.

If you wish to pay for the entire year in advance there is a discounted price of €380 as the annual fee.

Payment for both the monthly and annual options can be made via the school's Easy Payments Plus on www.hfcs.ie.

The following rules apply:

1. Students should bring a second lunch to be eaten prior to study. Please note that study begins at 3.55pm sharp in room A2. If students are late they are disrupting the learning environment for others and this is not acceptable. A register of attendance and lateness will be kept and parents will be notified via email if a student is absent for more than 3 days in the same week.
2. Each student will be assigned a place in the study room. Students must sit in their assigned seat for the duration of the study block.
3. No communication between students will be permitted. This includes borrowing of books and equipment.
4. Mobile phones are forbidden during study time. Students must use their iPad if they wish to access educational material online.
5. Students who are absent or leaving early must have a note from their parent/guardian in their dialann. This note must be presented to the study coordinator and/or supervising teacher at the beginning of the study session.
6. Students who are involved in extra-curricular activities must inform the Study Coordinator prior to the commencement of study otherwise they will be marked absent.
6. Students are not permitted to leave study to work on projects unless prior permission has been given by the subject teacher who will also be supervising these students. Under no circumstances are students to work unsupervised in any classroom.
7. Students must comply with the school's Code of Behaviour and the above regulations. If students breach the rules they may be asked to leave Supervised Study. There will be no refund of fees. The supervising teacher's decision is final. There will be no appeal.
